Speaker: Joe Keane P.E. Chief Engineer of MTA Bridges and Tunnels (MTA B&T)

Location: New York Athletic Club, 59th & 7th Avenue – 189 Central Park South

Topic: – Mr. Keane’s presentation will provide an overview of major concrete work recently completed or in construction at the MTA Bridges and Tunnels (MTA B&T) including the extensive work underway replacing the Queens and Bronx approaches to the Bronx Whitestone Bridge, as well as upcoming concrete projects.

As Chief Engineer of the MTA B&T, Joe Keane directs the planning, design, and construction of capital and major maintenance programs for seven bridges and two tunnels. He leads a professional staff of engineers, architects, and construction managers.

Mr. Keane directs a capital program budgeted at \$2.1 billion for the period 2010-2014, as well as \$220 million in expenditures on non-capital projects. He has been at the MTA B&T since 1988, and previously worked for the New York City Department of Transportation.
